Council's Community Grants Program supports a range of projects, events and activities occurring within the Town of Gawler. This year, eligible groups, organisations and individuals are invited to apply for up to \$1,000 to assist with community-focused initiatives that are of direct benefit to the Gawler community.

Initiatives may include, but are not limited to, activity in the following areas:

- Community events.
- Community focused programs and activities.
- Activity that encourages artistic expression.
- Activity that promotes cultural diversity.
- Awareness raising activities.
- Crime prevention and social justice initiatives.
- Community education, training, volunteering and engagement initiatives.
- Club/group operational expenses.
- Purchase of equipment or uniforms.
- Development and/or upgrade of facilities.
- Programs or services for marginalised groups.
- Initiatives that promote positive environmental outcomes and foster environmentally sustainable practices.

'Each year, through its Community Grants, Council supports a wide variety of initiatives that encourage community participation and contribute to the wellbeing of our residents. In the previous round of community grants, many local groups and clubs received funds for a wide range of fantastic initiatives; including club room renovations, upgrade of equipment, training and development, arts initiatives, uniforms, health and wellbeing initiatives, marketing and promotion, community events, sporting events and heritage tours.' says Mayor Karen Redman.

The Community Grants Program is Council's commitment to supporting a range of community led initiatives, projects, events and activities that foster opportunities for community development and participation, contribute towards community connectedness and add to the vibrancy of the Town.
