# Summer Treats

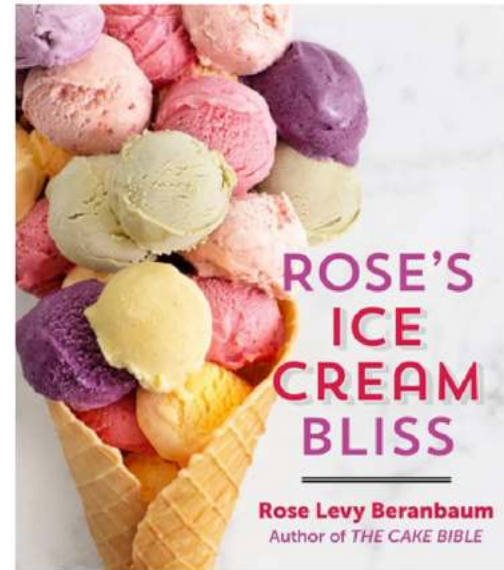
# OFF THE Shelf

## Clever Women in fiction

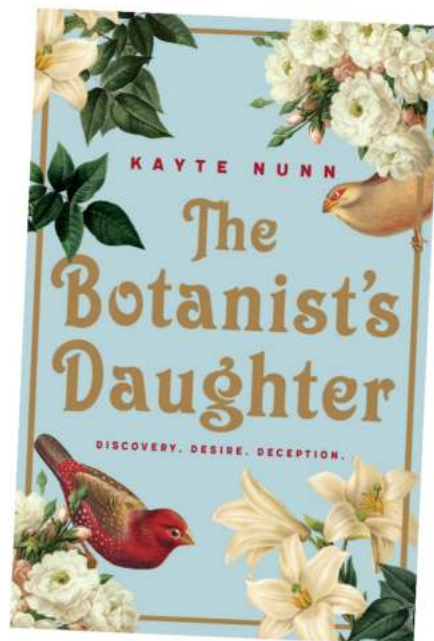
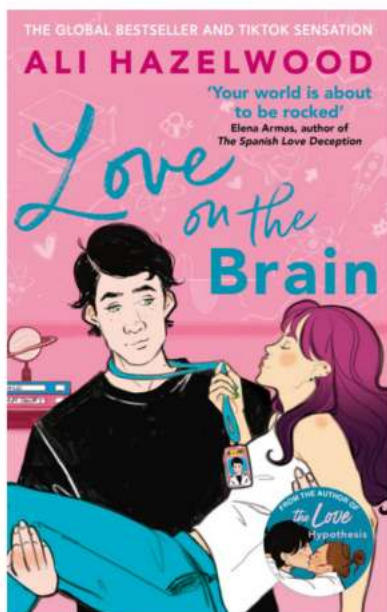
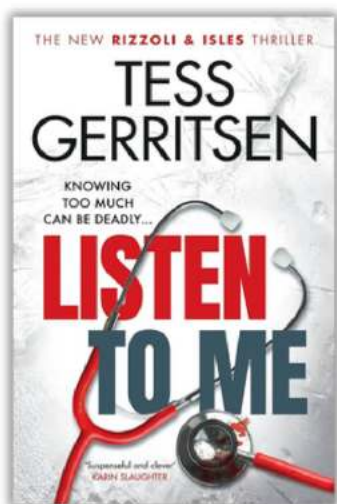
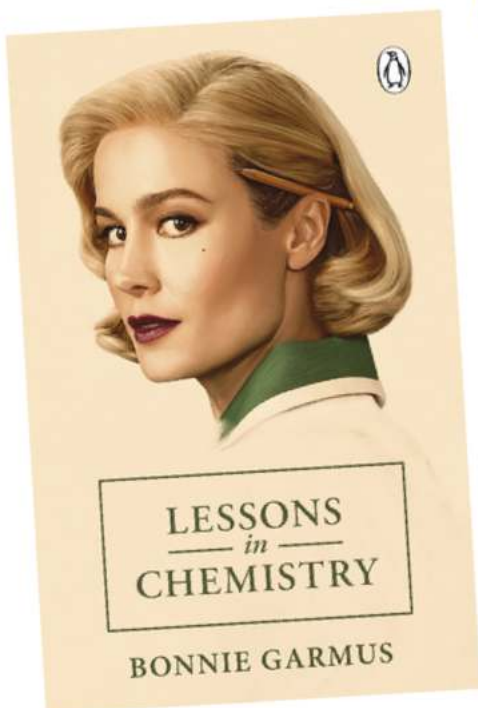

# WIND Down

Yoga breathing exercises are called Pranayama. *Prana* is the Sanskrit word for breath or life force, while *yama* refers to its movement and control. These breathing patterns may decrease stress, assist with sleep, and provide a mind/body connection as you concentrate on the technique. The library has many books and DVDs on yoga to explore the many types of yoga practices.

## Sheetkari Pranayama

*This practice assists with cooling the mind, body and emotions. Inhale slowly through gently closed teeth with lips slightly open, so that you feel cool air across your tongue. Exhale through the nose. Continue for a few minutes.*

## Nadi Shodana Pranayama

*Also known as Alternate Nostril Breathing promotes balance, between mind and body, and our active and passive modes. Begin by placing your middle finger on your forehead between the brows. Close the right nostril with your thumb, and gently inhale through your left nostril. Shut the left nostril with your ring finger and softly exhale through the right nostril. Inhale right nostril, close right nostril and exhale left nostril. Repeat for several minutes. Beginning and ending on the left side.*

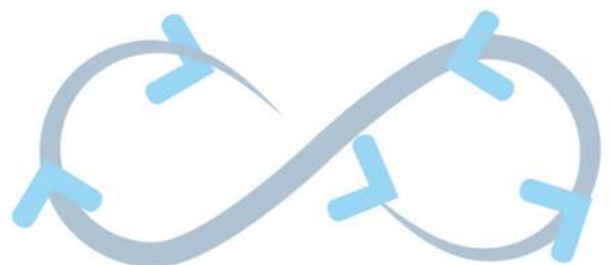
## Infinity variation

*Once you are comfortable with Nadi Shodana you may like to try a variation which does not require your hands. Visualise your breath following the infinity symbol. Breath up and around on the left side, down and out to the right. Then inhale up and around on right and out and down on left, following the unbroken figure 8 shape with your breath.*

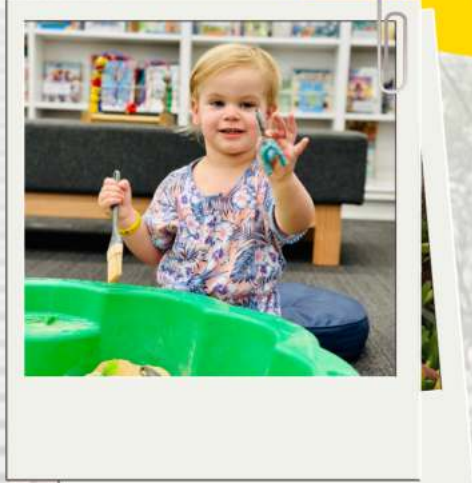

# AUTHOR Highlight

## Trent Dalton

Trent Dalton is one of those writers who can make you pause for a moment to let a beautifully crafted sentence sink in fully.

He is a proud Brisbanian and before turning to writing fiction, was an award winning journalist.

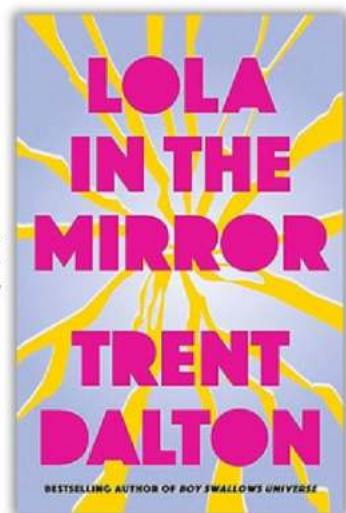
He burst onto the Australian literary scene in 2019 with his semi-autobiographical novel *Boy Swallows Universe*, which won four awards at the Australian Book Industry Awards (ABIAs). It won Book of the Year, Literary Fiction Book of the Year, the Matt Richell award for new writer of the year and Audiobook of the year.

The 8 part Netflix adaptation of the book is due to be released in January 2024 with the cast including Deborah Mailman, Bryan Brown and Christopher Baker.

In 2020 Dalton released another novel - *All Our Shimmering Skies*, and in 2021 he published *Love Stories* - a collection of heart warming love stories gathered from interviews with real people answering one simple question - "Can you please tell me a love story?"

His latest book *Lola in the Mirror* was released in October this year and follows the lives of a homeless, nameless girl and her mother. As with all of Trent's books it is filled with hope and love, and comes highly recommended by this librarian! Enjoy!

# WHAT'S In A Word?

When we think of summer, what words spring to mind? Possibly hot, dusty, air conditioning, swimming, bushfires, sunburn, cricket, or ice-cream. Here's a few more unusual words to add to your summer vocabulary.

**Estival** - an adjective used to describe something related to summer. Strangely enough this is not related to the word festival, instead coming from the Latin word for summer, aestas. Perhaps during summer our activities become more **vespertine**, and occur in the evening, such as an evening swim through a **moonglade** (an area of moonlight reflected on water).

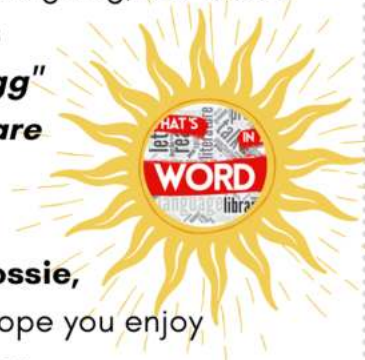


The Kurna name for the summer months is **warlitati**, while our Ngarrindjeri neighbours might say **waldi nanggi** when it's a hot day.

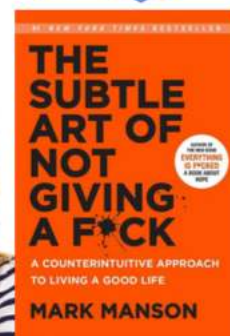
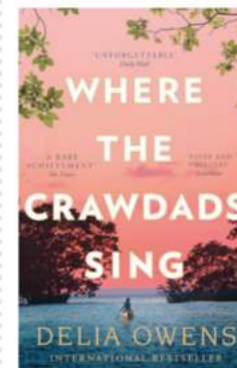
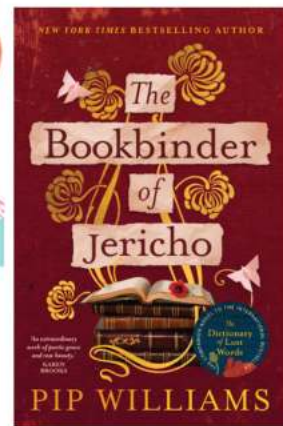
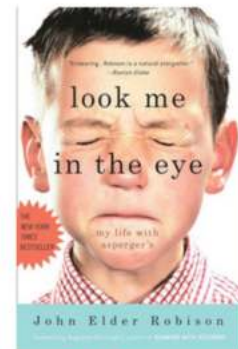
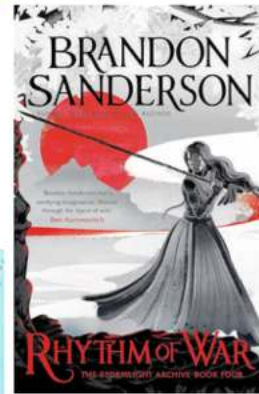
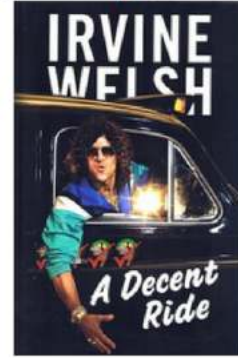
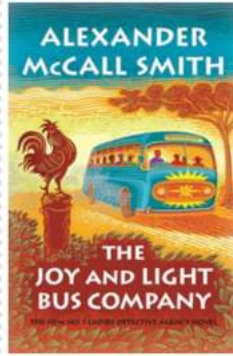
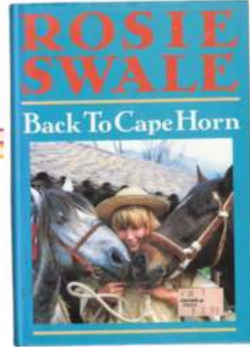

**From unfamiliar dogs to the cuddliest family pet, any dog can and will bite. And, for lots of reasons. So, it's vital we know the situations when and why dogs bite. Plus all the things we can do to interact with dogs safely.**

**To keep ourselves, our loved ones and greater community safe, let's get to know our four legged friends a little better, and lessen the chances of good dogs having bad days.**

- **Whether at home or out in public, always supervise children around dogs.**
- **Never enter a dog's territory, like their bed, yard or toy box.**
- **Never startle a dog.**
- **Never touch a dog while it's eating.**
- **Never touch a dog's puppies without the owner's permission.**
- **Never disturb a sleeping dog.**
- **Never put your face near a dog's face.**
- **Dogs do not like pats on the head.**
- **Teach children to always ask the owner's permission before approaching a dog.**
- **Teach children that dogs can bite when they're tired, frightened, annoyed, unwell or in pain and warning signals.**
- **When approaching a dog, slowly reach to touch its chest from the side. If it retreats, it's time to back off.**
