1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1 That it be a Policy of Council that it consider the painting of stobie poles subject to the Applicant:
 - 1.1.1 providing a description of the proposed design and colours;
 - 1.1.2 providing a site plan indicating the location of the stobie poles;
 - 1.1.3 obtaining approval from SA Power Networks;
 - 1.1.4 accepting to maintain the paintwork to a reasonable condition at all times which includes repainting following;
 - 1.1.5 any acts of graffiti; and
 - 1.1.6 accepting responsibility to consult with all residents in the street or with people who have an interest in the street.
 - 1.1.7 Submitting an application under Section 221 of the Local government Act 1999 to Alter a Roadway to Council.
- 1.2 Following consultation the matter shall then be referred to the Infrastructure and Environmental Services Committee for consideration.

2. REVIEW AND EVALUATION

The effectiveness of this Policy will be reviewed after each general election of Council.

The Chief Executive Officer will report to Council on the outcome of the evaluation and if relevant make recommendations for amendments, alteration or substitution of a new Policy.

The Policy will not be altered or substituted so as to affect a process already commenced.
