Terms and Conditions



VISIT PASS AND MEMBERSHIP TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The Gawler Sport and Community Centre has the right at any time to terminate a visit pass or membership of any person who fails to adhere to the Centre's rules and/ or does not comply with reasonable direction of the Centre staff. Additionally management reserves the right to suspend access if management is aware of any relevant charges being brought against a patron that could endanger the safety of any staff member or patron until such charges have been resolved. All visit pass and membership holders have the right to cancel their pass, without giving cause or reason, during the 48-hour period immediately after they enter into visit pass or membership agreement. Any requests for termination during the 48-hour cooling-off period must be made in writing to recreation@gawler.sa.gov.au.

DEFINITIONS

15 x Visit Pass - Visit passes are valid for 12 months. Visit passes may only be used by the person whose name appears on the card. Staff may request the person presenting the pass to show a valid form of ID. Visit passes are only to be used for casual sessions and not in conjunction with any other program or event. Any person not following the rules of the visit pass will have their pass terminated.

Membership - Memberships are valid for 3 or 6 months (depending on membership term purchased). Memberships may only be used by the person whose name appears on the card. Staff may request the person presenting the membership to show a valid form of ID. Memberships are only to be used for casual sessions and not in conjunction with any other program or event. Any person not following the rules of the membership will have their membership terminated.

Family - Admission for 4 people of any age who are in relation to one another.

CHANGE OF DETAILS

Please notify a staff member of any changes to your personal details for administrative purposes.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Use of Gawler Aquatic and Recreation Services facilities is done so at your own risk.
- Users are responsible for their own property and the safety of minors under their care.
- Please follow staff and official instructions at all times.
- All children under the age of 10 years must be accompanied into the centre with a parent/guardian or a responsible person aged 16 years or older.
- All Gawler Aquatic and Recreation Services facilities are smoke free. However, the smoking of cigarettes and electronic cigarettes are permitted outside the centre in the designated smoking areas.
- No discriminative, offensive or vulgar behaviour displays are permitted.
- Use of mobile phones, cameras and video cameras is restricted within the centre. Please speak to our staff for further information about our photography policy.
- Users are not permitted within the centre under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol. Drugs are not permitted within the centre. Alcohol is only permitted with the written approval of centre management, with a limited liquor license.
- Animals are not permitted within the centre without the prior approval from management. With the exception of assistance dogs and/or animals.
- Failure to comply with any of these conditions can create an unsafe and unpleasant environment for all users. Customers disregarding these conditions will be asked to leave Gawler Aquatic and Recreation facilities, with no refund.

SKATE FLOOR RULES

- No food or drink is allowed on to the skate floor
- Do not pick up or carry anyone while you are wearing skates
- Always travel in the crowd direction when entering and leaving the floor
- Foul, vulgar or abusive language or behaviour will not be tolerated and is to be reported to staff
- Jumping over the barriers is prohibited
- You must wear skates on the skate floor unless you are an adult helping a child to skate around. Please stay on the outside of the skate floor
- Skaters should not use or talk on mobile phones / electronic devices while skating, this includes taking photos on the skate floor.
- Playing tag and fast skating (except during specified times), pushing or interfering with other skaters is strictly forbidden. Skaters and or spectators participating in this behaviour will be removed from the centre.
- Please adhere to the directions and request from all Centre staff.
