Redevelopment of Gawler and District Netball Association Courts

Town of Gawler are thrilled to announce a significant milestone in the Gawler and District Netball Association (GDNA) court redevelopment project, as Camco are appointed to design and deliver Stage one of the project with works expected to commence on ground in March 2024.

Key Points

- This project was made possible through a \$4.8M election commitment by the Malinauskas State Government.
- The GDNA redevelopment project represents a significant investment in the future of netball in the region and will ensure a vibrant sporting environment for years to come.

The GDNA redevelopment project encompasses several key elements, including the demolition of the existing non-compliant courts and construction of 10 new compliant courts with improved drainage, new sports lighting systems, and improved car parking facilities. These enhancements will not only elevate the playing experience for netball enthusiasts but also enable the GDNA to host regional and state-level competitions, attracting teams from across the country.

Stage 1 of the project is based on the Essex Park and Gawler Showgrounds Sporting Precinct Masterplan produced by JPE Design in 2021 which proposed two stages for the redevelopment:

- Stage 1 (short term plan) includes construction of 10 new courts.
- Stage 2 (long term plan) includes construction of an additional 2 courts and an upgrade to the club room facilities.
