Gawler Aquatic Centre Terms and Conditions



OPENING DATES AND PUBLIC HOLIDAYS

Gawler Aquatic Centre opens Saturday 10 October 2020 and closes Thursday 1 April 2020. On public holidays the centre will be open between 12pm – 4pm. Gawler Aquatic Centre will be closed Christmas Day.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

All persons entering the Gawler Aquatic Centre are required to abide by the Centres Conditions of Entry. These conditions can be found at the entry to the centre.

SEASON AND VISIT PASS TERM AND CONDITIONS

The Gawler Aquatic Centre has the right at any time to terminate a season or visit pass of any person who fails to adhere to the Centre's rules and/ or does not comply with reasonable direction of the Centre staff. Additionally management reserves the right to suspend access if management is aware of any relevant charges being brought against a patron that could endanger the safety of any staff member or patron until such charges have been resolved. All season or visit pass holders have the right to cancel their pass, without giving cause or reason, during the 48-hour period immediately after they enter into season pass or visit pass agreement. Any requests for termination during the 48-hour cooling-off period must be made in writing to aquatic.recreation@gawler.sa.gov.au. A season or visit pass may be transferred into someone else's name providing that request is made in writing and a \$10 administration fee is paid. The Gawler Aquatic Centre has the right to further extend memberships and or visit passes, as a result of the implementation of state and or national restrictions applied due to the health safety concerns related to a pandemic and disater. Customers will not be eligable for a refund, only an extension of membership or visit pass.

DEFINITIONS

Season Pass - Season Passes are valid for 12 months. Season Passes may only be used by the person whose name appears on the card. Staff may request the person presenting the pass to show a valid form of ID. Season passes are only to be used for casual swimming sessions and not in conjunction with any other program or event. Any person not following the rules of the season pass will have their pass terminated.

15 x Visit Pass - Visit passes are valid for 12 months. Visit passes may only be used by the person whose name appears on the card. Staff may request the person presenting the pass to show a valid form of ID. Visit passes are only to be used for casual swimming sessions and not in conjunction with any other program or event. Any person not following the rules of the Multi visit pass will have their pass terminated.

Adult - Individuals 16 years and older who do not hold a valid Concession Card.

Child/Concession - Reduced fees for individuals who hold a valid Concession Card or Individuals under the age of 16 years.

Spectator - A person who is not participating in any activity or using any of the Centre's facilities.

Children Under 3 - Children under 3 are permitted entry to the centre free of charge. Children under the age of 3 need to be accompanied by a paying adult (as per Watch Around Water Policy)

Family - Admission for 2 adults and 2 children or 1 adult and 3 children.

Family Extras - any additional members of the family

Age requirements - Children aged under 10 years must be supervised by a parent, guardian or competent adult 16+ at all times when in any of the swimming areas.

CHANGE OF DETAILS

Please notify a staff member of any changes to your personal details for administrative purposes.

SWIM NAPPY POLICY

All children 3 and under are required to wear an approved swim nappy at all times when they are in the water. This is to ensure patron safety and to maintain the highest possible water quality. Patrons will be asked to display evidence of a swim nappy at the pool entrance or at the start of their swimming lesson. Regular nappies do not qualify as swim nappies as they can swell and break open leaving unwanted gel in the water. Disposable or reusable swim nappies are available for purchase at the kiosk.

FILMING AND PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

- 1. The use of all electronic devices in change room areas is strictly prohibited.
- 2. Any person requesting the use of an electronic device for photography or to film someone must agree and sign the electronic devices consent form available at the Kiosk. During this process the person will show a valid form of ID to a Gawler Aquatic Centre Staff Member and allow for their details to be recorded in our database.
- 3. Upon signing and agreeing to the terms and conditions the person will be issued with a red wristband which identifies them to the public and staff as having read and understood the terms and conditions of electronic device policy.
- 4. Anyone without a red wristband taking photos or filming will be asked to cease doing so and asked to comply with the current policy. In suspicious circumstances the person using an electronic device may be asked to show management any photos and/or film they have allegedly taken, failure to do so may result in the police being called.

LOST PROPERTY

Lost property such as googles, swimwear or personal accessories is kept on site for a maximum of two weeks. After two weeks all googles, swimwear and personal accessories will be donated to charity. Personal accessories such as rings, wallets, phones will be kept in the safe for two weeks and handed over to the police after such time. We strictly prohibit loaning or handing out lost property.

LIGHTNING

The presence of lightning around an outdoor pool poses a serious safety risk. When lightning is within 10km of the Centre the water must be immediately evacuated. The "Flash-to-Bang" measurement of approximately 30 seconds between 'flash' and the 'bang' indicates that lightning is 10km away. Once lightning has moved 10km away or 30 minutes after the last thunderclap patrons may re-enter the water. Please be aware that no monetary refunds will be given to patrons in the event of an evacuation due to lightning.

POOL RULES

Please ensure you are following the pool rules at all times, follow the instructions of staff and enter the water in a safe manner at all times. The pool rules are in place for the enjoyment and safety of everyone at the Centre. The Watch Around Water Policy must be adhered to at all times.
