## **KEY OUTCOMES SUMMARY**

### **GRFMA Board Meeting – 19 August 2021**

#### **Flood Hazard Mapping and Assessment Project**

The meeting received a presentation from the Attorney-General's Department on the Flood Hazard Mapping and Assessment Project. The State Government project will review flood hazard planning in South Australia to align with national best practice approaches, benchmarks and standards.

#### **GRFMA Financial Statements 2020-2021 and Annual Report**

The meeting adopted the:

1. Audited Financial Statements for the year 2020/2021;
2. Schedule of Constituent Council's Interest in Net Assets as at 30 June 2021; and
3. 2020/2021 Annual Report.

#### **GRFMA Advocacy**

The GRFMA Chair will write to all local State and Federal Government MP's to provide an update on the current status of GRFMA projects as a relationship management process leading up to the 2022 elections.

#### **GRFMA Strategic Plan**

A progress report on the GRFMA Strategic Plan was received and the meeting resolved that the Chairperson write to Constituent Councils seeking to facilitate a meeting of all the respective Mayors and Chief Executive Officers which would discuss the draft Strategic Plan as prepared and seek to find a way forward to progressing a Plan that meets all Councils' expectations.

#### **Land Management**

The meeting endorsed works for the next stage of revegetation of GRFMA land surrounding the Bruce Eastick North Para Flood Mitigation Dam.

The Executive Officer was requested to initiate action for removal of Graffiti at the Bruce Eastick North Para Flood Mitigation Dam and to investigate options and costings for placement of security camera surveillance.
